# **Quick start - Bluetooth**

With the Pluggerz Protect & Communicate Bluetooth you can listen to music, navigation or speech while protecting your hearing.

### **Application**

For listening to music, two way communication, using a (wireless) walkie talkie or navigation system in a noisy environment.

#### The filter

The Bluetooth headset has a flat filter with an attenuation of 17 dB. The complete attenuation values are as follows:





### Charging


Fully charge the Bluetooth headset before first use. The headset is fully charged in about two hours and one battery charge will last about 10 hours (300 hours in stand by mode).






# Using the headset

You can connect the headset to the Custom-Fit earplugs by removing the filter from the earplugs. Take the grip on the earplug and gently pull it out of the earplug. Then, press the speaker of the headset in the opening of the earplug. The earplugs fit correctly when the tip points down and the L/R mark matches the L/R mark on the headset.



# **Functions & control**

The Bluetooth headset has various functions, which you can control with the three buttons on the headset



The Multi Function Button (MFB knop) is the middle button on the headset (see image above).

### On/off and connecting to a device

Turn on headset

Hold the MFB button for about 2 seconds to turn on the headset. The light next to the + button will shortly turn blue.

Connecting to Bluetooth device After turning on, the headset will automaticaly look for available Bluetooth devices. The light next to the + button will blink red and blue while searching for a device to connect with. On the device you want to connect the headset to, select the headset in the Bluetooth settings and select 'connect'. The connection is established successfully when the light on the headset blinks slowly for about 8 seconds.

If the headset is not connected with a device within 2 minutes, it will go into stand by mode and automatically turn off 3 minutes later.

Disconnecting and connecting to a new device

If the devices get disconnected, the headset will automatically search for a new device to connect to.

Turn off headset

The headset can be turned off by holding the MFB button for 3 seconds. The light next to the + button will shortly turn red.

### Incoming calls

Answer/end call Shortly press the MFB button once to answer

an incoming call. The microphone of the headset is located next to the - button. To end

a call, press the MFB button again.

Refuse call If you want to refuse an incoming call, hold the

MFB button for 2 seconds

Call the last number To start a call with the last number called,

called shortly press the MFB button twice.

Multiple phone calls When another call comes in while being in a

call, you can answer or refuse it.

To answer it and end the current call: press the

MFR hutton once

To answer it and have a waiting call, press the MFB button twice (you will stay in the current

call)

To refuse the second call, hold the MFB button a little longer to refuse the second call and

continue the current call

## Playing music

Play/pause music After connecting to a Bluetooth device, press

the MFB button once to play the last played song. Press the MFB button again to pause the

music.

Next/previous song To play the next song, hold the + button for

about 2 seconds. To play the previous song, hold the - button for about 2 seconds

Increase/decrease By pressing the + button, you can increase volume

volume. If you press the - button, the volume

will decrease.
